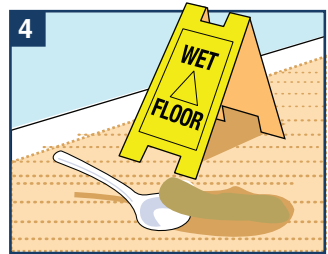
1 Gather equipment.



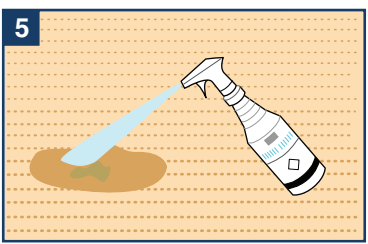
2 Wear proper personal protective equipment.



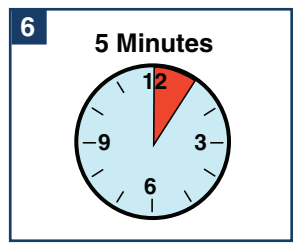
3 Place wet floor signs.



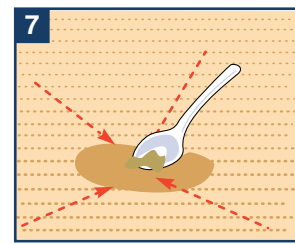
4 Remove excess solids.



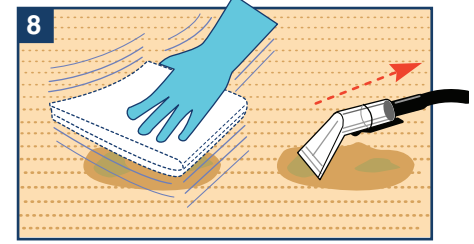
5 Apply water, then the proper chemical to the spot.



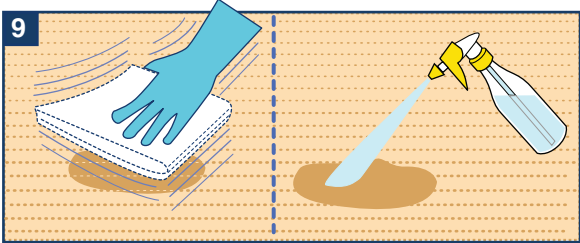
6 Allow 5 minutes dwell time.



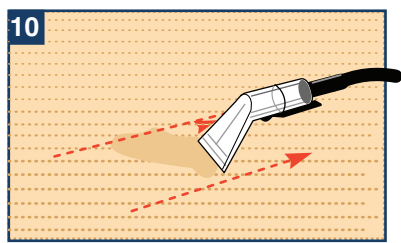
7 Using a blunt edge, gently agitate toward the center of the spot.



8 Either blot with a clean white towel or extract with a hand extractor. Do not rub spot.



9 When hand spotting, blot up spot and rinse with clean water. Repeat as needed. Do not rub spot.



10 When using a hand extractor, rinse carpet with clean water. Repeat as needed. The final pass should be without water.

= Green Cleaning Process

Green Cleaning Tips

- Clean up spills as soon as possible.
- Try to minimize the amount of moisture applied to the carpet.
- Notify occupants when removing spots in a facility.
- Particular attention should be paid to food spills so as to prevent pests in the area.
- Use properly diluted products, preferably through a dispensing system.
